Goldenraintree	<i>Koelreuteria paniculate</i> (Warning: rare ALB host)
Hawthorns	<i>Craetagus</i> spp
Honeylocust	<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>
Juniper	<i>Juniperus</i> spp
Larch, American	<i>Larix laricina</i>
Lilac, Japanese Tree	<i>Syringa reticulata</i>
London Planetree	<i>Platanus x acerifolia</i> (Warning: ALB host)
Oak, Northern Red	<i>Quercus rubra</i>
Osage Orange	<i>Maclura pomifera</i>
Pine, Pitch	<i>Pinus rigida</i>
Pine, Austrian	<i>Pinus nigra</i>
Spruce, White	<i>Picea glauca</i>

Ironwood	<i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>
Junipers	<i>Juniperus</i> spp
Linden, Littleleaf	<i>Tilia cordata</i>
Maple, Red	<i>Acer rubrum</i> (Warning: <u>prime</u> ALB host)
Maple, Sugar	<i>Acer saccharum</i> (Warning: ALB host)
Oak, Pin	<i>Quercus palustris</i>
Redbud	<i>Cercis canadensis</i>
Pine	<i>Pinus</i> spp., except Pitch Pine and Austrian Pine
Serviceberry species	<i>Amelanchier</i> spp.
Tuliptree	<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>

**BEST SMALL STREET TREES UNDER WIRES (Small height and width, salt and drought tolerant)**

Hawthorns	<i>Craetagus</i> spp
Amur Maackia	<i>Maackia amurensis</i>
Crabapple (columnar types)	<i>Malus</i> spp
Flowering Cherry	<i>Prunus sargentii</i> ('Accolade')

**BEST LARGE STREET TREES NOT UNDER WIRES (Canopy trees, not low-branched, salt and drought tolerant)**

Bald Cypress	<i>Taxodium distichum</i>
Ginkgo	<i>Ginkgo biloba</i> (non-native)
Hackberry	<i>Celtis occidentalis</i>
Hickories	<i>Carya</i> spp
Honeylocust (thornless)	<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>
Kentucky Coffeetree	<i>Gymnocladus dioicus</i>
Oaks	<i>Quercus</i> spp (except Pin Oak which is very salt sensitive)
Sweetgum	<i>Liquidamber styraciflua</i>
Tupelo	<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>
